


#### Demolition Debris Diversion Ordinance

**Purpose**: To establish a program for recycling and salvaging of construction and demolition (C&D) materials, as prioritized within the Cook County Solid Waste Plan.

#### **County Goals**

Reduce the overall amount of C&D waste generated.

Prevent improper disposal or dumping of C&D within Cook County (by tracking materials diverted from the wastestream).

Recover material value through reuse/recycling from materials that would have been otherwise discarded and value lost.

### The Requirements

Residential structures (SF-1 to 4 units): 70% diversion w/5% reuse

Commercial/Industrial/Residential (4+ units) structures: 70% diversion

Diversion plans/reports required at the start and completion of the project


